 - 3. Read strategically
 - Be selective when reading to help make sure you incorporate relevant I into your work – speak with your Academic Liaison Librarian

- o Read over the relevant sections in detail and make notes at the same time
- 4. Be an active note-maker
 - Be specific about how the point you are writing down relates to your assignment
